



## **ETHEL BOYCE ACHIEVEMENT AWARD**

### **Criteria**

**Mrs. Ruth A Laing created the ETHEL BOYCE ACHIEVEMENT AWARD in 1998 through a donation in memory of her sister Miss Ethel Phoebe Boyce.**

**Miss Boyce was an avid softball player who had a professional and personal interest in people. She was particularly interested in young people and helping them to succeed in life.**

**The award is administered by Softball Canada and is given annually awarded to a female and male recipient. It is expected that the award winners will have exhibited leadership traits and skills in softball. Both recipients receive \$1,000. The award is meant to help defray the costs of education and/or playing softball. The award winners will be announced at the annual Softball Canada Congress (formerly known as the Annual General Meeting).**

**To qualify for this award the applicant must be:**

- Registered with a provincial/territorial association**
- A resident of the province or territory**
- In attendance at a recognized Canadian post secondary educational institution, or plan on attending one in the following year**

**Softball Canada by September 15 of each year must receive a letter of application, a completed application form, along with a letter of endorsement from the provincial/territorial office.**

**Note: Reference letter(s) must be included whenever possible.**
